Press Release

Dixie Highway over the Cass River Bridge Replacement

Project Description: The Dixie Highway Bridge over the Cass River, built in 1931, is 240 feet long, and serves as one of four crossings of the Cass River that are under the jurisdiction of the Saginaw County Road Commission. Over time the bridge has deteriorated to a point where the outside shoulder of the bridge had to be blocked off. In 2008 the bridge was selected for funding by the MDOT Regional Bridge Council. The new structure will be 265 feet long.

Project Funding: The project is being funded by the State of Michigan Local Bridge Program and the Saginaw County Road Commission. The bid price for construction is \$2,879,813.99.

Traffic Considerations: The roadway and bridge will be closed to traffic during the construction operations, and traffic detoured.

Construction Schedule: Construction of the project is scheduled to begin on May 2, 2011 and open back to traffic by November 14, 2011.
