

**APPLICATION FOR EXTENDED TRANSPORTATION PERMIT ON  
SAGINAW COUNTY ROADWAYS FOR THE MOVEMENT OF  
OVERSIZE AGRICULTURAL IMPLEMENTS**

**Conditions and Restrictions:**

1. Subject to the conditions, restrictions and approval, this permit for the transportation of oversize agricultural equipment has been issued for movement on all county roads.
2. The driver of the vehicle shall carry the original permit in the vehicle to which it applies and shall have it available for inspection by any police officer, motor carrier officer, or agent of the Saginaw County Road Commission.
3. Insurance coverage required in the law of this state shall be in effect for moves operating with an overweight or oversize permit as per additional requirements on page 2.
4. Any of the following actions shall immediately void the permit and subject the applicant to appropriate legal action: (a) Misrepresentation of information set forth in an application for permit. (b) Noncompliance with the conditions, restrictions or provisions on which a permit is issued. (c) A change or erasure on a permit.
5. Permits are not valid for periods extending beyond the expiration date of vehicle registration. Extended Permits will not be issued for a period of less than 30 days.
6. Permits will be issued only for vehicles owned by the applicant or operated under a bona fide lease or rental agreement. Each vehicle within a combination of vehicles (tractor, semi-trailer, lowboy, etc.)
7. All axle weights must be legal. Permit not valid on highways which are posted for lighter than normal loadings and vehicle exceeds axle loading as posted, or when restricted loadings are in effect.
8. The vehicle covered by this permit shall not exceed 35 M.P.H. at any time.

## EXTENDED TRANSPORTATION PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

- 1) Permit valid only if favorable driving and traffic conditions prevail. Daylight hour only. Permits are not valid on Saturdays, Sundays, nor during the period beginning at 12 noon on the day before and continuing until 12 noon of the 1<sup>st</sup> day after the holidays here listed: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. When the holiday occurs on a Friday or Monday, permits will not be valid for the period beginning the noon before the three-day weekend, and ending the noon of the 1<sup>st</sup> day after the three-day weekend.
- 2) The movement shall not impede other traffic in an unreasonable manner and at no time shall traffic be blocked from use of the highway. Vehicles and loads shall not be parked on the highway at any time.
- 3) Vehicles shall be registered as required by the Michigan vehicle code and will not violate any statute or valid ordinance, rule or regulation by any state agency or sub-division of the state. Vehicles are to comply with all statutory provisions as to other permits, licensing, motor vehicle equipment and operation.
- 4) Applicant agrees to accept responsibility for any damage caused to wires, mailboxes, trees, buildings, or the road, including the structures and appurtenances, and shall reimburse the appropriate parties for any damage caused by the moving of said vehicle or load. Applicant agrees to hold harmless, indemnify, defend, and represent the Board against any and all claims for bodily injury or property damage, or any other claim arising out of or related to the moving of said vehicle, load, or its presence on or use of the highway by said vehicle and load.
- 5) Permits are not valid if insurance expires. Application to present evidence that at least the following insurance coverage is in full force and effect on each vehicle while operating on the public highway under this special permit:

Bodily Injury liability – each person.....	\$500,000.00
Bodily Injury liability – each accident.....	\$1,000,000.00
Property Damage liability – each accident.....	\$1,000,000.00
Single Limit policy.....	\$1,000,000.00
Workers Compensation.....	Statutory Coverage
- 6) The permittee or contractor shall name the Saginaw County Road Commission as additional insured and certificate holder, by name, on any general comprehensive liability insurance or commercial general liability insurance carried by the permittee or contractor worded as follows: The Board of Saginaw County Road Commissioners, the Saginaw County Road Commission, and their officers, agents and employees, are named as additional insured parties.
- 7) Permits will be issued only for vehicles owned by the applicant or operated under a bona fide lease or rental agreement. (Copy to be provided to road commission) The applicant may be required to deposit a reasonable inspection fee and to furnish a good and sufficient cash bond to cover any damage that might occur to roads, bridges, or highway structures, by the movement of vehicles and objects under the proposed permit.
- 8) Towing vehicle shall be at least a 1 ½ ton truck with dual rear wheels. Each vehicle within a combination of vehicles used in transporting Agricultural Implements (tractor & trailer or tractor & semi-trailer) must have a valid permit.
- 9) When width exceeds 12 feet: Shall be followed by one escort vehicle (passenger car or pick-up truck) with at least one flashing or rotating amber light on top of cab, a reasonable distance in rear of the movement when moving on a four or more lanes. To be preceded by one escort vehicle (passenger car or pick-up truck) with at least one flashing or rotating amber light on top of cab, at a reasonable distance in front of the movement when on less than four lanes. Amber lights are to be visible for 360 degrees for distance of 500 ft.
- 10) The Saginaw County Road Commission may temporarily suspend or revoke a Extended Transportation Permit, either in its entirety or in respect to certain of its provisions, due to **special conditions** or if it is in the interest of the public's safety.
- 11) The vehicle shall not be loaded or unloaded within the outer shoulder limits of any county road unless permitted by an officer or the Saginaw County Road Commission.
- 12) Units exceeding 80 feet in overall combination length: At least 2 flashing or rotating amber lights to be placed on the extreme rear of load and one on top of the towing vehicle. All flashing or rotating amber lights are to be visible for a distance of 500 feet.
- 13) Movement shall display 6 clean, plain, red or orange flags of at least 18 inches square, one on each bumper of towing vehicle supported on a short shaft at an angle so as to wave freely, and one on each corner of mobile home or building module so placed that they can be clearly seen by approaching traffic.
