# MANDATORY Personal

#### **Protective Equipment:**

- Safety vest (when off equipment in right-of-way).
- Boots.
- Hard hat (when off equipment).
- Eye protection.
- Hearing protection (when

required).

- Gloves.
- First Aid Kit.

### Sequence of Basic Job Steps:

- Daily Vehicle Condition Inspection.
- 2. Unload roller from trailer.
- 3. Back and forth in project area.
- Load onto trailer, if needed see load securement.

#### **Recommended Safe Job**

#### **Procedures:**

- 1. Wear PPE listed.
- 2. Unload/load on level ground.
- 3. Make sure ramps are secure.
- 4. Watch for low limbs or wires.
- 5. Tighten tie downs.
- 6. Roll protection (if applicable).
- 7. Fire extinguisher available.
- 8. First Aid equipment available.
- 9. Sunscreen.
- 10. Wear seat belt if equipped with roll protection.
- 11. No one around machine while running.
- 12. Use vehicle strobe light.
- 13. Use vehicle hazard flashers.
- 14. Radio communication.



## Potential Accidents and Hazards:

- Traffic.
- Hit by a vehicle.
- Debris in eyes.
- Low limbs or wires.
- Small roller can tip over easily.
- Fatigue from sitting.
- Fire.
- Sunburn.
- Back/muscle strain.
- Slip, trip and fall.
- Heat exhaustion.
