MANDATORY Personal Protective Equipment:

- Safety vest (when off equipment in right-of-way).
- Boots.
- Hard hat (when off equipment).
- Eye protection.
- Hearing protection (when required).
- Gloves.
- First Aid Kit.

Sequence of Basic Job Steps:

1. Daily Vehicle Condition Inspection.
2. Unload roller from trailer.
3. Back and forth in project area.
4. Load onto trailer, if needed see load securement.

Recommended Safe Job Procedures:

1. Wear PPE listed.
2. Unload/load on level ground.
3. Make sure ramps are secure.
4. Watch for low limbs or wires.
5. Tighten tie downs.
6. Roll protection (if applicable).
7. Fire extinguisher available.
8. First Aid equipment available.
9. Sunscreen.
10. Wear seat belt if equipped with roll protection.
11. No one around machine while running.
12. Use vehicle strobe light.
13. Use vehicle hazard flashers.
14. Radio communication.



Potential Accidents and Hazards:

- Traffic.
- Hit by a vehicle.
- Debris in eyes.
- Low limbs or wires.
- Small roller can tip over easily.
- Fatigue from sitting.
- Fire.
- Sunburn.
- Back/muscle strain.
- Slip, trip and fall.
- Heat exhaustion.
